THE RETIRED ELDER GEOFFREY THUO NG'ANG'A

BIRTH

The Late Rtd. Elder Geoffrey Thuo Ng'ang'a was born in 1946 at Mitahato Village in Kiambu County. His parents were Late Evanson Ng'ang'a & Peris Nyakiringa. He was brother to: Joshua Kiigi, Jonah Ndua, The Late Macharia, The Late Waithera, Grace Wambui, Samuel Mwaura, Hannah Nuna, The Late Ruth Nduta and The Late Margaret Njambi.

SCHOOL

In 1953 he joined Mitahato Primary School upto 1954 and thereafter joined Karia Primary School upto 1957. He then joined Thika Technical and Trades School in 1962.

WORK

In 1963 to 1964 worked with E.A. Railways and Harbours, then worked with KCOFFs Seed Merchants as a Store Manager in 1966. In 1967 he joined EABA & Shell upto 1969 as Regional Manager.

In 1970 to 1972 while working with Nairobi City Council he studied at KIA and attained a Diploma in Administration. He worked with the above organisation upto 1983 when he started his own business and farming.

MARRIAGE

In 1971 he married Jane Wanjiru Thuo and were blessed with children: Peris Nyakiringa & (David Waiganjo), Esther Muthoni & (James Ngugi), Eunice Waithira, Evanson Ng'ang'a & (Rosemary Wachuka) and George Gitau & (Rose Njeri). After his beloved wife Jane Wanjiru passed on in the year 2000 having suffered a long illness, He married Gladys Wangui Thuo and were blessed with children: Lawrence Mathenge & Eva Wanjiru and David Ng'ang'a.

The late Rtd. Elder Geoffrey Thuo was blessed with 16 grandchildren and 3 great grand children.

CHURCH

The Late Rtd. Elder Geoffrey Thuo was born in a Christian family and joined his parents at P.C.E.A. Mitahato Church from childhood.

He was baptised in 1956 by The Late Rev. Marima. He served Chairman for Youth Fellowship in North

Kiambu Presbytery in 1964. From 1976 he served as a Deacon at P.C.E.A. Kiamwathi and Minanini congregation in Ndarugu Parish.

In 1978 he was ordained as an Elder at Ndarugu Parish, Minaini congregation and became chairman. In 1979 he transferred to Mathare Parish in Nairobi Presbytery, Githurai congregation. In 1990 he took TEE Course and attained Diploma in Theology.

In 1993 he moved to Thome to start P.C.E.A. Thome congregation. In 1997 he moved to Ruai and joined PCEA Ngundu Church in Ruai Outreach, Nairobi Central Presbytery (current Ruai East Parish, Nairobi East Presbytery).

He later in 2005 moved to PCEA Gituamba and transferred back to PCEA Ngundu Church in 2010 as the LCC Chairman. The late Elder Geoffrey retired as an active Elder on the 11th October 2015 after serving for 37 years.






